Applications

Over the period there has been eight applications submitted to the CEC Planning authority for: three home extensions, a conservatory, a windows replacement in the conservation area, a alteration to a house and to build a dwelling house at Rosshill and Forth Place.

QDCC has received representations from the neighbours of the Rosshill development seeking to have the application refused. QDCC has been given an extension to respond to the Planning Authority.

Decision List

The authority granted six applications; erection of telecoms mast and equipment, an alteration, two property extensions, new external lighting to be fitted to Dalmeny Church and retrospective approval to Scotts Ice Cream shop for the fitting of the new canopies above the shop front.
