>> Councillor Hutchison - Report

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>> Full Council

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>> Full Council returned after recess with a marathon meeting on Thursday 22nd August. Key decisions included the postponement of a decision on the voting rights of religious representatives on the Education, children and families committee, and the still somewhat sketchy arrangements for continuity during the Council Leaders Adoption Leave.

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>> Full Council will meet again in Thursday 19th September at 10am in the City Chambers.

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>> Almond Neighbourhood Network

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>> I have no further information at present on the operation of neighbourhood networks going forward.

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>> The North West Locality Planning Partnership, on which the Almond Neighbourhood Network will be represented will have it's first meeting on Thursday 3rd October at 6.30pm, venue to be confirmed. I will be sitting on the Partnership as the elected member representative from the Almond Ward.

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>> Local Issues

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>> Dalmeny Park Street Design - Following representations from residents I am looking into issues with street design in Dalmeny Park particularly around pedestrian safety and the lack of traffic calming measures. I am keen to ensure that this is married up with any work already being undertaken in this area.

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>> Voting Rights of Religious Representatives - By far the largest volume of correspondence received from Queensferry residents were on the issue of the voting rights of religious representatives on the Education, children and families committee. The Conservative group was opposed to the Green Party proposal, however as mentioned above a decision has again been deferred. It is worth noting that not a single letter was received by me from Queensferry residents in support of the proposal.

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>> Queensferry High Street - Due to the overrunning of the Council meeting I was unable to attend the Queensferry High Street project meeting on 22nd August.

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>> In addition this month I have also assisted residents with street lighting, roads issues, bin complaints and disability assistance.

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>> Unfortunately due to other commitments I was unable to attend or participate in any of the programme of events for the Ferry Fair. I am pleased to see that as ever the event was a great success despite the challenges posed by the wildly variable weather.
