### **Cllr Norman Work's report for February 2014 meeting**

I have been dealing with two separate issues relating to street lighting. One issue is lighting at Rosebery Hall and the other is street lights which were reported on the QDCC facebook page. The lights at Rosebery Hall have been checked by someone but I have not heard if they have been fixed yet. I passed on details of lamp post which needed attention to the lighting team and I will monitor the situation.

I attended Queensferry High School Parent Council meeting on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February. QHSPC wish to have stronger links with QDCC.

I attended an Elected Members briefing on the Queensferry Crossing on 11<sup>th</sup> February at the Contact and Education Centre.

On 31<sup>st</sup> January I held a meeting with Graeme McGartland from Corporate Services about the facilities the sea cadets use at Port Edgar. The Sea Cadets are asking for CEC to help provide them with a better hall and also to help with the short lease they still have. As a result of this meeting Graeme and I met on site with Colin Butcher on 11<sup>th</sup> February to tour the facilities which the sea cadets use at Port Edgar. I will keep QDCC updated on any progress.

I held my Queensferry surgery at Echline Primary School on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> February

I attended the Queensferry Infrastructure Improvement Group meeting in the Burgh Chambers on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February

I attended the FETA meeting on February 21<sup>st</sup> with Cllr Paterson.

New Stagecoach service; There has been much correspondence between QDCC & Elected members regarding bus services in Queensferry. I forwarded on emails from Terry Airlie to Ewan Horne & Cllr Leslie Hinds to answer concerns QDCC had raised in relation to introduction of a new service. I also was tasked with finding out if the rumours were true that First were withdrawing their service as there had been no official notification from First. It has now been confirmed that First are withdrawing their X4,X43 & 43 services from April 20<sup>th</sup> 2014. Stagecoach have at least acknowledged some of my tweets on the matter but Lothian buses have still to respond however they did respond to a member of the public to why Lothian refuse to service Queensferry.
