<b>WA04 - Queensferry / Dalmeny</b>

<b>Crimes of note throughout this period</b>		
<b>Date</b>	<b>Crime Type</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>13/07/14</b>	Murder	About 0140 hours, 13 <sup>th</sup> July 2014 at The Loan, South Queensferry a 20 year old local male was subject to an assault, this sadly resulted in his death. Two persons, a male and a female, are remanded in custody pending trial.
<b>05/07/14</b>	Serious Assault	A 29 year old male was assaulted within a private dwelling by a male known to him. As a result a male has been charged with the assault.
<b>28/06/14</b>	Various Offences	On 28 <sup>th</sup> June 2014 a 29 year old local male was responsible for causing a disturbance in a licensed premises. As a result of this incident the suspect has been charged with various offences including assault, failing to keep a dog under control and possession of a offensive weapon. The dog has been seized by police pending a court ruling.

**WA04 - Queensferry / Dalmeny  
Community Policing Team**

The CPT, Community Policing Team (previously known as SNT, Safer Neighbourhood Team) took up residence at South Queensferry Police Station on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2010. On 13<sup>th</sup> January 2014 the team was expanded under a new Community Policing model.
