**Almond Safer Neighbourhood Team**

The CPT, Community Policing Team (previously known as SNT, Safer Neighbourhood Team) took up residence at South Queensferry Police Station on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2010. On 13<sup>th</sup> January 2014 the team was expanded under a new Community Policing model.

The team is now supervised by Inspector Chris Scobbie who took over the area on 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2014.

The team consists of 13 Community Constables and the emphasis will be on Partnership working in a bid to solve local issues. Our principal partners will be those living and working in the Almond Ward and the City of Edinburgh Council.
