WA04 Almond Safer Neighbourhood Team

The CPT, Community Policing Team (previously known as SNT, Safer Neighbourhood Team) took up residence at South Queensferry Police Station on 21st September 2010. On 13th January 2014 the team was expanded under a new Community Policing model.

The team is now supervised by Inspector Chris Scobbie who took over the area on 22nd December 2014.

The team consists of 13 Community Constables and the emphasis will be on Partnership working in a bid to solve local issues. Our principal partners will be those living and working in the Almond Ward and the City of Edinburgh Council.
