# **Stopping Up Order - Lovers Lane**

QDCC have been trying to find out when this will be resolved but no date as yet. It has been passed to the Scottish Ministers but there seems to have been delays in being registered. Concerns are being voiced by local residents in the Sommerville Gardens/Scotstoun Avenue area regarding the speed of vehicles(at times) entering and leaving the Dalmeny Park development but planned traffic calming at this location cannot be taken forward until the stopping up issues are resolved.
